PANTOMIME COVID PROTOCOL

Sitges ETC will follow the COVID guidelines laid down by **CATSALUT** at all times. Please be aware that this might change according to how the pandemic develops and may even result in the Panto having to be cancelled. This may also result in members of the cast not being able to continue with rehearsals or even take part in the dress rehearsal or show.

USE OF MASKS

Current guidelines in place mean that masks will need to be worn at rehearsals. We want to ensure that the dress rehearsal and the performance can go ahead without masks whilst still protecting all members of the cast. For this reason, anybody who has not been fully vaccinated or had COVID within the last 6 months will be required to take a lateral flow test (antígenos) at the chemist before the dress rehearsal.

POSITIVE CASE IN THE GROUP

If somebody in the group tests positive for COVID, current guidelines regarding anybody who was in close contact with that person state that

- Fully vaccinated people or anyone who has had COVID in the previous 6 months should take a lateral flow test at a chemist. If the result is negative they are not required to self-isolate.
- Anybody who is **not** fully vaccinated and has not had COVID within the previous 6 months must test a PCR test **and** self isolate for 10 days, even if the result of the test is negative.

CONTACT WITH A POSITIVE CASE

If anybody in the group has had close contact with somebody who has tested positive for COVID they should take a test.

If they are fully vaccinated or have had COVID in the last 6 months this would be a lateral flow test at the chemist. If the result is negative they are not required to self-isolate.

If they are **not** fully vaccinated and haven't had COVID in the last 6 months, they will be required to take a PCR test **and** self-isolate for 10 days even if the result of the test is negative.
