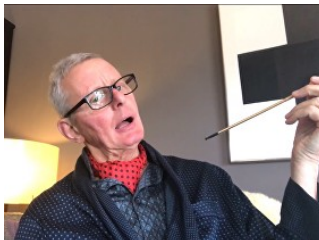


## Sitges Has Talent 2021
